TUESDAY

DAY 1: DEPARTURE DAY

DAY 6: HAIFA, AKKO, SAFED, UPPER GALILEE

AM Breakfast. We begin our tour at the ancient port city of **Akko** to visit the prison where members of the Hagana and Irgun were held captive during Israel's fight for independence. Here Leon Uris's famous novel *Exodus* was filmed. Continue to the beautiful new Jewish development town **Karmiel** in the **Galilee**. Proceed to **Safed**, famous art colony and center of mystic kabbalah. See its synagogues and picturesque cobblestone streets and art galleries before arriving at our kibbutz, located in the lush hills of the Upper Galilee.

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
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
